Community ~ Jos' Golf Day

McLauchlan & Partners recently participated in a Charity Golf day held at the Burleigh Golf Club to raise funds for local business man and friend Jos Harrington who, on original diagnosis, was thought to have suffered a major brain hemorrhage.

He was taken to Gold Coast Hospital after complaining of a headache and collapsed outside the emergency doors. He was immediately admitted to hospital, underwent emergency surgery and was then taken to intensive care on life support.

Later scans and assessments determined that it had not been a burst blood vessel as originally thought, but the exact cause of the bleeding could not and still has not been determined.

Jos and his wife Sumana ran a cleaning and catering business called Mr. Housekeeper on the Gold Coast but since his health episode, the business has suffered enormously.

As a self employed couple, money stopped coming in immediately and Sumana had to turn her attention to trying to get Jos through a very difficult period of their lives.

They had no insurance and limited savings, so their financial situation is far from brilliant.

The Charity Golf day was organised by golfing friends of Jos' and saw over 50 guests attend and donate much needed funds through hole sponsorship, green fees, raffle prize donations as well as cash donations.

In total over \$10,000 was raised for Jos and Sumana on the day which will certainly help to ease some of the financial burden.
